ENTRIES CLOSE AUGUST 15

Late entries close August 31 and entry fee is double the standard fee.

*** ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE: \$25 per head to create jackpot.***

SPECIAL RULES

- 1. READ GENERAL RULES.** All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.
- 2. JACKPOT BREAKDOWN.** Grand Champion will receive 70% of Jackpot and Reserve Grand Champion will receive 30% of Jackpot. Jackpot is \$25 additional entry fee times number of head entered.
- 3. WEIGH-IN.** Steers will be weighed upon arrival. Jackpot Steers weighing less than 900 lbs. will be disqualified with no refund of entry fee or jackpot fee. ALL animals MUST BE ENTERED IN THE NAME OF THE OWNER.
- 4. INSPECTION.** Each animal is subject to being inspected by a veterinarian or competent authority for verifying the ages of steers and heifers; animals with two permanent teeth shall automatically be entered into the heavyweight class regardless of their weight. If animal exceeds two (2) permanent teeth, the steer is disqualified.
- 5. STEER CLASSES.** Lightweight, Mediumweight and Heavyweight; with entries divided equally among the classes, without regard to the breed. If the total entries do not divide evenly, the larger class would first be Lightweight, then Mediumweight.

- 6. HEIFER CLASSES.** Must have been born between Sept. 1, 2009 - Aug. 31, 2011. Heifers cannot have calved. Heifer classes will be divided by age following entry.
- 7. HEIFER ELIGIBILITY.** Show is open to any female beef heifer. Entry fees paid in other Eastern States Exposition beef shows do not cover entry in the Jackpot. (Example: An Angus heifer may be entered in the ESE Angus Show and in the Jackpot for a fee of \$16 for Angus Show, \$16 for Jackpot Show and \$25 to create Jackpot.)
- 8.** Heifers will be judged as breeding females.

PROSPECT STEERS / PROSPECT HEIFERS

*** ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE: \$25 per head to create jackpot.***

- 1. JACKPOT BREAKDOWN.** Grand Champion will receive 70% of Jackpot and Reserve Grand Champion will receive 30% of Jackpot. Jackpot is \$25 additional entry fee times number of head entered.
- Prospect calves are those that show evidence of ability to grow and take on additional weight. Prospects must be of recognized beef breeds or beef crossbreeds.
- Prospect calves must be born after Jan. 1, 2011. Calves showing excessive age may be eliminated from competition at the discretion of the Exposition.
- Calves entered in these classes must be free of unmarketable defects. All prospect calves must be castrated.
- All calves will be weighed upon arrival and classified. Steer calves must weigh less than 750 lbs.
- All prospect heifers will show together regardless of breed. Classes will be determined by age.
- All prospect steers will show together regardless of breed. Classes will be determined by weight.
